The ballet performance is at the Old Post Office Playhouse in Newton. We will drive there in our car, park, and walk to the

I will sit and wait for the ballet to begin. Someone will come onstage before and during the show to tell me about it.

I will watch the dancers move their bodies to the music to tell the story of the *Nutcracker*.

The dancers will use their bodies to tell the audience how they are feeling.




I'm going to see dancers dressed as different characters to tell the story of the *Nutcracker*. Different characters will have different costumes. I can learn about these costumes before I come.

Sometimes the music is fast. Sometimes the music is slow. Sometimes the music is loud. I can cover my ears if the music gets too loud.




I can click <u>HERE</u> to listen to the music before coming!
